## **RUNNING CLUB - 7:45 am to 8:15 am (K-6)**

Running club will be on this Tuesday.

It was fantastic to see 325 students last Tuesday morning, 81 more students than our first week last year. We also ran an extra 107km compared to the first week last year. It's a great start so far!

Our school goal this year is to run 5000km by the end of term 3. This year, we are aiming to run around France, from the Paris Eiffel Tower and back to Paris to the Arc de Triomphe. Year 3 to 6 students will follow the running club progress as part of their French lessons.

As communicated to parents via Connect on Wednesday, the Department of Education is negotiating with the State School Teachers' Union (SSTUWA) and Principals' Federation of Western Australia to reach an industrial agreement. ### **ANZAC DAY PUBLIC HOLIDAY**

Anzac Day is a public holiday and the school is closed.

Anzac Day falls on the 25th of April each year. The 25th of April was officially named Anzac Day in 1916. 'ANZAC' stands for Australian and New Zealand Army Corps.

On the 25th of April 1915, Australian and New Zealand soldiers formed part of the allied expedition that set out to capture the Gallipoli peninsula. These became known as Anzacs and the pride they took in that name continues to this day.
