
Getting your child to and from Piara Waters Primary School



We want every child to arrive at school and leave safely. We appreciate that we are a large school and there is a lot of traffic at drop off and pick up times. The Early Childhood carpark and the Kiss & Drive are the most effective ways to collect your child after school. If everyone follows the processes for these two areas, then our students are safe and the areas will flow smoothly.

Families and students are encouraged to walk, ride or scoot to school. There are areas to safely leave bikes and scooters locked inside the school gates during the day.

If you or your child have a disability and you require access to an ACROD bay, please contact the school so that we can assist you.

Kiss & Drive (Wright Road)













1. Enter Kiss and Drive at the first marked 'Kiss & Drive' bay, which is after the crosswalk on Wright Road. Pull up into available bays marked 'Kiss & Drive'. Please remain in your vehicle. If all Kiss & Drive bays are full, please do not stop. You will need to do another lap around the block and re-enter the Kiss & Drive zone.

2. Students will be waiting in the shelter. If your child is not at the shelter, please do another lap around the block to assist with traffic flow. Students can only enter cars that are stationed in the marked 'Kiss & Drive' bays.

3. Please do not stop in the 'BUS ONLY' bays. The bus bays are for Transperth, school and daycare buses only.

4. As the car in front of you pulls out, all cars should slowly move forward into the next available bay to assist with traffic flow. Once your child is secured in the car, please indicate, and slowly exit Kiss & Drive onto Wright Road.

5. The Kiss & Drive zone is supervised by a member of staff from 2:30pm – 2:45pm.

Early Childhood Carpark (Pleasant Ave)





1. Enter the Early Childhood carpark on Pleasant Ave. For the safety of our students, please park in the available bays only.



2. Please do not park in the 'No Standing' areas. For everyone's safety, students should only enter cars that are parked in the marked bays.



3. If there are no available bays, please exit the carpark and make your way back around to the entry point. The Early Childhood Carpark is not a Kiss & Drive zone.



4. A friendly reminder to leave the ACROD bays for those who are eligible and need them most.
