

Dear parents and carers,

As you are aware, your child has been finalizing their Science project for the upcoming Science Showcase Evening, which is on **Thursday, the 14th of November 2024**.

The Science Showcase is an opportunity for families, friends and wider school community to view our students' ideas and efforts as they attempt to answer real-world questions relevant to them through Science and Science Inquiry. Our year 6 students are the focal point of the evening. We will also have entries from the STAWA Science Talent Search on display and extension class work.

SHOWCASE EVENING DETAILS

- **Time:** 5.30 to 7.00 p.m.
- **Presentation Areas:** Undercover Area, Drama Room and Senior Science Room
- **Dress code:** School Uniform or Smart Casual Attire or students may wear something that matches their project (e.g. yellow shirts to match a project about lemons)

DROP OFF AND PICK UP DETAILS

- Students are required to be at school and report to their respective presentation areas between **5.20 and 5.30 p.m.**
- Students have been advised that if they require more set-up time, they should arrive punctually to allow themselves ample time to get their exhibit ready. Doors will open at 5.15 p.m.
- At the end of the showcase, students are to be picked up from their presentation areas between **7:00pm and 7:15 p.m.** Attached is the list of presentation areas.

- Supervision of the year 6 students will be provided by the Science Teachers, Principal and Deputy Principals, between 5:15pm and 7:15pm.

- Students are encouraged to eat before they arrive at 5:20pm.
- Students are required to bring a water bottle.
- We will provide the year 6 students with a simple snack pack (eg juice box and muffin) at approximately 6 p.m. If your child has a special dietary requirement, then please pack them a snack for the session.
- The P&C will have a sausage sizzle, bake sale and there will be an ice-cream van. Students must have a member of their team at their science project board at all times.

VOTING

- All parents and community members are invited to visit the showcase and view the student presentations between 5.30 p.m. and 7.00 p.m.
- Everyone will vote for their favourite projects. The project with the highest votes will win the Community Choice award, which will be presented at the finals showcase on Friday.

Classroom showcase and student voting

Evening Community and Parent Showcase



Thursday, 5:15pm to 7:15pm

- Students will arrive between 5:15pm and 5:20pm and set up their projects in their designated area.
- The showcase opens to parents and community at 5:30pm and closes at 7:00pm
- Students will pack up and go home between 7:00pm and 7:15pm
- Anyone visiting the expo (parents, community members, special guests, siblings etc) will choose their favourite 2 projects to vote for in the Community Choice Award.
- Students need to eat before the session, and bring a water bottle.
- Students can wear smart casual, or school uniform, or clothes to match their project.

Friday Finals



- If a student's project is selected, they will also display and present their project at the Friday Finals.
- The student choice award from Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday will be presented.
- The Community Choice award from Thursday evening will be presented.
- The staff selected finalists from Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday will be presented.

All finalists will be judged by a new judging panel on Friday, and trophies awarded to the winners.
