YEAR 6 SCIENCE LITERACY "NAPLAN" TEST

On **Thursday**, **26 May** (8:30am), all year 6 students will participate in the NAPLAN Science Literacy Test. This is a new assessment, which we have opted to complete as a school. We will provide further information closer to the test date.

These new assessments are part of the <u>National Assessment Program</u> and completely optional for schools. These new assessments will be phased in over 3 years, **starting with science literacy in 2024.** Civics and citizenship will be added in 2025, followed by ICT (information and communication technology) literacy in 2026. From 2026, NAP Opt-in assessments in all 3 domains will be available each year.

Through taking part in this assessment in science literacy we will be able to:

- 1. Measure student performance against national standards in science literacy.
- 2. Use the results to review, plan and adapt our science teaching and learning programs.

NATIONAL SIMULTANEOUS STORYTIME – DRESS UP (ALL K-6 STUDENTS)

On Wednesday, 22 May, students are encouraged to come to school in their Pyjamas - for a gold coin donation to our P&C.

On this day, it is the <u>National</u> <u>Simultaneous Storytime</u> and classes will be joining in the reading of "Bowerbird Blues", at 9am, with other schools across Australia.



INTERSCHOOL AFL-W GIRLS CARNIVAL (YEAR 5 AND 6 STUDENTS)

Year 5 and 6 students have had the opportunity to try out and train for the Interschool AFL-W carnival that will be held on **Thursday**, **23 May**.

YEAR 5/6 PUBLIC SPEAKING EXTENSION – SPEECH PRESENTATIONS

On **Thursday**, **9 May** all year 5/6 students participating in the Public Speaking extension program will present their speeches on the topic "What will I be doing in 2050?". Parents are welcome to attend.

Our top three students will then represent our school at the Inter Electorate Primary School Public Speaking Competition 2024. Students from primary schools in the Armadale / Darling Range / Jandakot electorates will participate in this public speaking competition, sponsored by Local State Members of Parliament, Dr Tony Buti MLA, Hugh Jones MLA, and Yaz Mubarakai MLA.

It is proposed that Round 1 of this competition be held around **Friday**, **17 May**, with Round 2 (the final) to be held on **Friday**, **21 June** at Parliament House.



SCIENCE EXTENSION COMPETITION (YEAR 5/6)

Students in the science extension program in year 5 and 6 will be able to be selected in our interschool team in the <u>SciencelQ</u> online competition. A team of four students in year 5 and also year 6 will compete in this new competition.

JUNE

MUSIC CONCERT (YEAR 2-6 CHOIR AND YEAR 4-6 IMSS STUDENTS)

On **Wednesday**, **5** June, our choirs and IMSS music students will be performing for family and friends by putting on a morning music concert in the Undercover Area. The concert will be held between 1:30pm and 2:30pm in our undercover area.

FACTION CROSS COUNTRY CARNIVAL (YEAR 1 – YEAR 6 STUDENTS)

On **Friday**, **14 June**, all Year 1 to 6 students compete in their year levels / gender to run their cross-country race around the school, earning points for their faction. The top 10 students from each race receive a certificate, and the top 2 students receive a Champion and Runner Up medal presented to them at the presentations. The top placed runners in year 3 to 6 will be selected for our Interschool Cross Country team in term 3.
