## OSH (BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL CARE) PLACES

Following feedback from parents about the difficulty in obtaining a place in the Piara Waters Primary School [OSH program](#), I met with the providers last week.

As a result of this meeting, the number of places in the after-school care and vacation program will be expanded. We have nominated some rooms that can be used for this program expansion, and these are currently being assessed and licensed by OSHClub and the governing authority. When the licensing and approval process is complete, we will advise (as will OSH) of the additional places available.



In the interim, OSHClub suggests parents continue to review the [booking system](#) for cancellations. If you have a booking and will not be utilising it, cancelling ahead of time will free up spaces for families.


