


TERM 2, WEEK 5 UPDATE

KINDERGARTEN, PRE-PRIMARY AND YEAR 7 ENROLMENTS FOR 2026

Kindergarten, Pre-Primary and Year 7 enrolments for 2026 close on the first Friday of term 3 (25th of July).

- All 2025 kindergarten students must apply to re-enrol in Pre-Primary for 2026. Students who live within the school's local intake area are guaranteed a place, but you still need to re-enrol.
- Current Pre-Primary to Year 5 students do not need to re-enrol for 2026 unless moving schools.

Secondary school enrolments are now open for next year until 25 July. If your child starts Year 7 next year, now is the time to apply to enrol. Please be aware enrolment into secondary school is not automatic. It requires you to submit an application with the secondary school of your choice.

YEAR 3 – ROOM 31 AND 32 FIRE SAFETY INCURSION

Today, fighters from The Armadale Fire Station will visit students in Rooms 31 and 32, as part of the DFES Year 3 Home Fire Safety Program. Students will further their understanding of;

- The role of a firefighter.
- How to prevent or stop a fire emergency from happening.
- How to respond to a beeping smoke alarm.
- Calling emergency services.
- Crawling low under smoke.
- Having a home fire escape plan.



The lesson will conclude with students having the opportunity to view and interact with fire vehicles. We would like to thank Mr Hogan, a parent from Room 3, who is also a fireman, for giving these classes an opportunity to learn about fire safety from professionals. As we have so many classes, it wasn't possible for all year 3 students to be involved in this particular incursion, within the available time of the station.

ACARA ITEM TRIAL 2025 – TESTING NAPLAN QUESTIONS

PWPS is one of approximately 400 schools to be selected by the Australian Curriculum, Assessment and Reporting Authority (ACARA) to participate in this year's Item Trial. The purpose of the Item Trial is to evaluate potential NAPLAN test questions ('items') for use in future NAPLAN tests. Your child's involvement and the results from the trial will help ACARA ensure that NAPLAN tests are valid, reliable and fair for all students.

About the Item Trial

- The Item Trial is about testing the questions, not about testing your child or their ability. Your child's results will not be reported.
- Tests being trialled are Reading, Numeracy, Conventions of Language and Writing.
- Selected students will sit two Item Trial tests.
- The tests will be administered at the school by external invigilators on **28 May and 29 May**.

Students for the Item Trial testing will be selected from:

- Year 3 – Room 30, Room 31, Room 34 and Room 36
- Year 5 – Room 10 and Room 11

The remaining selected students will participate in the ACARA Item Trial test today, which will be administered by external invigilators.

Protecting children in their digital worlds is an ever-evolving task for Australian families. Now more than ever, parents seek guidance in managing screen time and navigating the world of games and social media.


We are excited to support our parent community by hosting an important education session with ySafe, Australia's leading provider of online safety education. Here's what you can expect from this session:
