RELIEF TRAFFIC WARDEN POSITION

If you are interested in becoming a traffic warden or are available to do relief traffic warden work, please submit an application to the Children's Crossing Unit.

The WA Police Force employs Traffic Wardens on a casual basis. To become a traffic warden, you need to:

- Have access to email
- Have a full driving license and access to a vehicle
- Be available to work an hour in the morning and an hour in the afternoon

• Complete and submit an application to Children's Crossings Unit www.police.wa.gov.au/Traffic/Childrens-Crossings-Unit/Traffic-Wardens
