SWIMMING PERMISSION AND ENROLMENT NOTES

Swimming information and permission notes and forms will go home today to all Pre-primary to Year 4 students.

Permission forms are due back to classroom teachers by no later than **Monday, 5 August**. This is a firm deadline, as we need to confirm with the Department of Education student numbers so that sufficient Swimming Instructors are employed.



Payment is not due until the end of Term 3, **Friday, 20 September**.

Students who are away, and not taken their forms home by Wednesday, will have forms emailed to them.

Swimming information, permission notes and forms will be emailed to parents of absent students today.

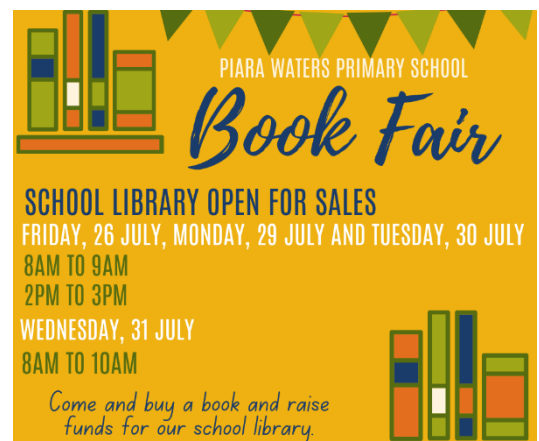
BOOK FAIR - LIBRARY

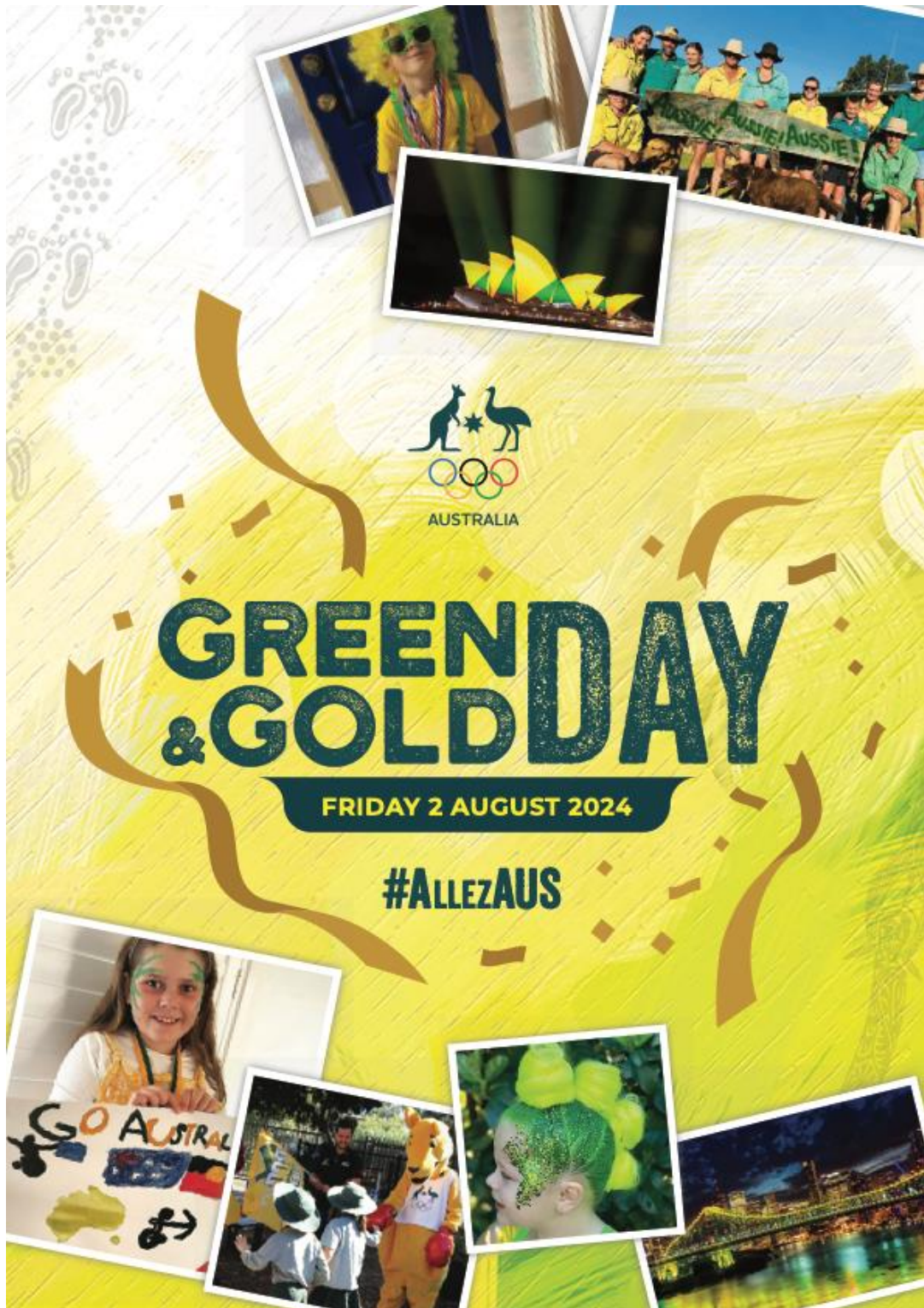
SENIOR ASSEMBLY – YEAR 3, ROOM 35 AND 36
