
Dear Parents and Carers

Thank you to everyone who did their bit to make it a great Faction Athletics Carnival!



CLASS PLACEMENTS FOR 2025

If you have specific requests for more than one child, please complete multiple surveys (one per child). The survey closes at midnight on **Monday**, **28th October**. (The survey link will not work after this date)

Parents will be notified by email of their Pre-Primary to Year 6 child's 2025 class placement by **Tuesday**, **26 November**.


Today, we acknowledge our excellent teachers on World Teachers' Day.
