

Dear Year 5 and 6 Parents and Carers,

Piara Waters Primary School runs a number of extension programs each term. These programs aim to challenge and extend student's knowledge and skills in their areas of strength. The programs also aim to develop students' employment skills, such as communication, teamwork, problem-solving, initiative and enterprise, organisation, resilience and critical thinking.

Science Extension Program

The Year 5/6 Science extension program will be led by Ms Vanitha Ram, who is the Senior Science Teacher at Piara Waters Primary School over 15 weeks over Terms 2 and 3.

To begin with, students will be learning about a chosen scientist and his/her discovery. Then, they go on to work on student-led group investigations. Over the course, students will have the opportunity to research, plan and conduct investigations. To conclude, students will present their findings and reflections.

Completed projects will be showcased in our school during National Science Week and submitted into the Science Talent Search 2024.

When will the program take place?

The students will work with Ms Ram from an hour each week. They will be withdrawn from their regular class program at this time and will need to catch up on work as required by their class or respective specialist teacher. The program will commence in Term 2, Week 2.

How are students selected for this extension program?

This program is recommended for students with a strong interest in Science and Science inquiry. A student who signs up to this program should also be able to attend weekly sessions over the period stated, be motivated to contribute to the tasks and work collaboratively.

Students will self-nominate by returning the attached form to the front office by Wednesday, 20th March 2024. The form includes a compulsory short 100-word or less write-up by the student explaining why they would like to participate in this program.

Students will be selected based on the write-up and information from classroom teachers, Miss Ramm will announce who is selected on Thursday, 28th March 2024.
